Tips for recruiting for this event

- Start close to home, ask your local DFA groups and members to attend and make sure you create an event through the DFA website
- Ask members to bring someone with them to the event
- Recruit widely: former volunteers, friends, family, voter lists, work colleagues, youth groups, Democratic Party activists, student groups etc...
- Contact a local candidate to coordinate your event with them and ask them to help recruit people for the event
- The best recruiters are existing volunteers, so ask your best members and volunteers for help!

Running your event

- Have fun!
- Plan ahead for the location, get permission to use that space
- Set a convenient time for the event to be held
- Start and stop on time
- Make sure you have all necessary supplies
- Make sure all attending event feel welcome and engaged
- Keep a good attitude, no matter how many people show up to the event!
